Clinical Quality Management Consumer Peer Review

The Chicago Department of Public Health, as the grantee for the Ryan White Part A service programs, is required to ensure that continuous quality standards are met by those provider delegate agencies receiving funding. The CQM review process has been implemented to:

1. Assess the ability of consumers to receive and be offered quality care and services consistent with the Ryan White Part A requirements;
2. Ensure the agency is adhering to the guidelines developed by Health and Human Services and local Standards of Care for Part A providers;
3. Identify met and unmet needs of consumers receiving services; and
4. Identify opportunities for improvement to enable provider agencies to enhance their service delivery areas.

The Chicago Department of Health HIV Division is dedicated to the meaningful inclusion of persons living with HIV/AIDS in the quality management process. It is expected that consumer Peer Reviewers will serve as a team member with other professional consultants to evaluate and examine service delivery and performance of agencies that provide Ryan White core and supportive services to patients in the Chicago Eligible Metropolitan Area (EMA) using established quality indicators.
